7. ACTION ITEMS

- A. Mosquito and Vector Control Association (Appendix I) General Manager Downs discussed participation in the NPDES Permit Coalition Monitoring Program. By participating in this coalition MVCAC will; implement, manage, and administer the statewide coalition monitoring and reporting program under the General Permit. Along with the cost benefits of joining the NPDES coalition, the responsibility for water monitoring compliance rests with the coalition instead of each individual district. It is pertinent to comply with the State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) with this initial monitoring plan so they can collect the data needed regarding water quality issues related to pesticide use. The MVCAC NPDES coalition will continue to work with the SWRCB on finalizing the permit.
- ** Motion was made by Trustee Saavedra and seconded by Trustee Cowen to Participate in the MVCAC NPDES Permit Coalition Monitoring Program. *Motion passed unanimously.*
 - B. Research Grant Mosquito Research Foundation (Appendix II) General Manager Downs discussed a \$10,000 research grant to the Mosquito Research Foundation. The grant would fund the specific project; Risk of Introduction and establishment of emerging arboviruses in California [Grant 2010-3] conducted by Dr. Reisen, Center for Vectorborne Diseases, University of California, Davis. This study will expand surveillance testing to detect endemic and/or new viruses. Currently testing is only for West Nile, St Louis encephalitis and Western Equine encephalitis viruses. A discussion ensued regarding any profit the Luminex Corp. would receive by their Xtag technology being used to screen mosquito pools in this study.
- ** Motion was made by Trustee Pellegrini and seconded by Trustee Bana to Approve a Grant to the Mosquito Research Foundation. *Motion passed*.

C. MVCAC Trustee Advisory Committee - Trustee Belleci requested ratification of his appointment as Secretary of the MVCAC Trustee Advisory Committee. It was determined that the Board of Trustees would like to read the Advisory Committee Bylaws before making a decision and ratification will be discussed again at the March Board of Trustees Meeting.

8. INFORMATIONAL REPORTS

- A. <u>Biology and Identification of Bay Area Mosquitoes</u> Steve Schutz, Scientific Program Manager, reviewed the biology and basic identification of local mosquito species. Specifically focusing on the 23 species in Contra Costa county and their habitats, hosts, diseases and the time of year they are active. The PowerPoint presentation allowed an in depth look at the developmental stages of mosquitoes and anatomy of adult mosquitoes.
- B. <u>Mosquito Research Foundation</u> The Mosquito Research Foundation (MRF) is a non-profit foundation founded by the Mosquito and Vector Control Association of California (MVCAC). The MRF has been redesigned with a vision to aid agencies in funding research and most importantly to direct some of that research. The foundation will solicit donations for research projects from service and supply vendors used by member agencies.
- C. Reports of Conferences/Meetings Attended (Appendix III) Trustee Howell and Trustee Haegeland attended the California Special Districts Association (CSDA) How to be an Effective Board Member workshop in Sacramento and encouraged all new board members to sign up for this informative training.
