A motion was made by Trustee Howell to recommend to the full board in July, an increase to the salary range, Assistant Manager, of 4.0%, and to reconsider this salary range and job description again next year, seconded by Trustee Cowen. *Motion passed unanimously*.

A motion was made by Trustee Pellegrini to recommend to the full board in July, an increase to the salary range, Information Technology Technician, of 2.5%, seconded by Trustee Odunlami. *Motion passed. Ayes: Howell, Pellegrini, Odunlami. Nays: Cowen, Mank*

All other salary ranges reviewed were determined to be in appropriate market range.

The committee reviewed the proposed job description and discussed the role of the position.
