## FOGGING FOR MOSQUITOES TO BE CONDUCTED FRIDAY MORNING ON BETHEL ISLAND

**WHAT/WHY:** The Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District will be fogging by truck to control high numbers of adult mosquitoes on Bethel Island.

**WHEN:** Friday, October 6, 2006. Fogging will take place at approximately 6:00 a.m., weather permitting.

**WHERE:** Stone Road and North Stone Road on the south, Gateway Road and Piper Road on the north, South Willow Road on the east, and Bethel Island Road north of Gateway Road on the west.

**TREATMENT:** will be made with truck-mounted ultra-low-volume equipment using <u>Pyrenone 25-5</u> <u>Public Health Insecticide</u> (pyrethrin) applied at a rate of .75 oz/ acre.

**ACTION REQUIRED BY RESIDENTS:** None. All products used are approved by the Environmental Protection Agency for the use of controlling mosquitoes and protecting public health.
