FOGGING FOR MOSQUITOES TO BE CONDUCTED TOMORROW EVENING IN MARTINEZ

WHAT/WHY: Due to the high number of mosquitoes in the area, the Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District will be fogging by truck to control adult mosquitoes.

WHEN: Thursday, October 2, 2008. Fogging will take place between dusk (approximately 6:50 p.m.) and 10:30 p.m., weather permitting.

WHERE: Martinez:

The area bordered by North Court Street at Martinez Regional Shoreline Park on the west, the Carquinez Straits' Shoreline on the north, Amorco Road on the east, and Marina Vista on the south.

TREATMENT will be made with truck-mounted ultra-low-volume equipment using_Resmethrin 4.14% at a rate of 1.5 ounces per acre.

ACTION REQUIRED BY RESIDENTS: None. All products used are registered with the Environmental Protection Agency for the use of controlling mosquitoes and protecting public health
